Attention 4th, 5th, and 6th Grade Parents:

The Duke University Talent Identification Program (T.I.P.) would like to invite eligible Tchefuncte Middle School students to participate in the 4th–6th Grade Talent Search program.

To be eligible, students must meet **one** of the following requirements:

1. Have a score at or above the 95th percentile on any one accepted subtest or total battery/composite on an approved grade-level achievement test, aptitude test, mental-ability test, or approved state criterion-referenced test. Scores from two years prior to their current grade level are accepted.
2. Score a minimum of 125 on the full scale or composite score of an approved IQ test that is no more than two years old.

If your child applied in 4th or 5th grade, he/she does **not** need to reapply in 5th or 6th grade.
